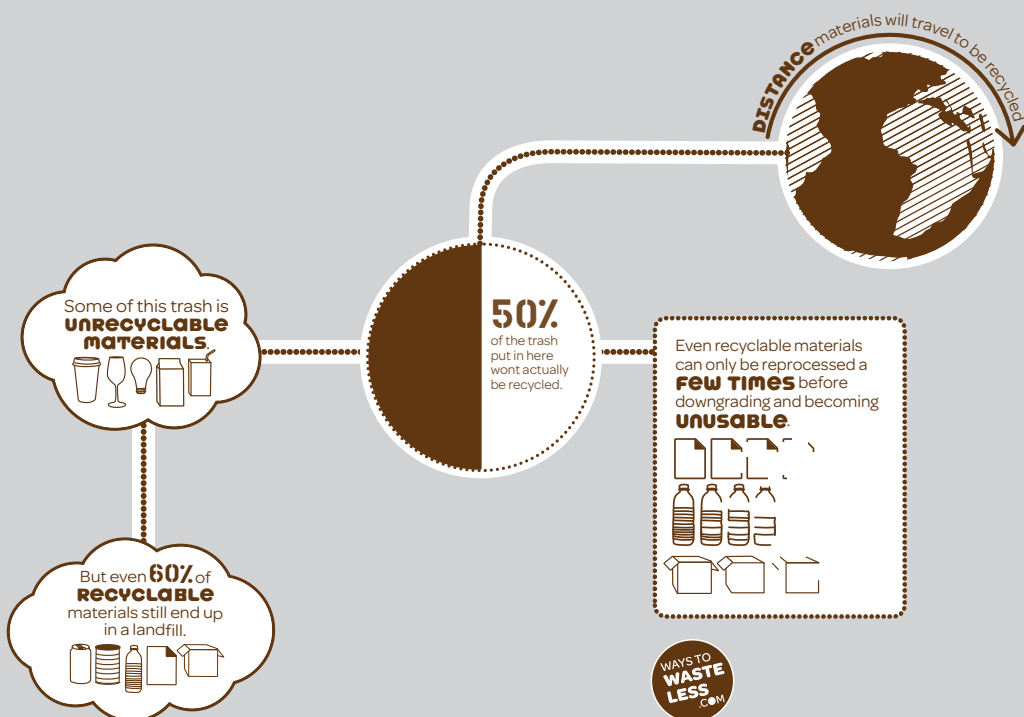

How to make WHEAT PASTE:

INGREDIENTS: flour, water, sugar

1. Add cold water to 3 tablespoons of flour. Stir until it's a runny mix
2. Put one cup of water in your pot, heat it until it's almost boiling.
3. Put the cold wheat-water-mix in it slowly while stirring constantly with the beater/ fork. (leave the pot on the hot plate while doing this).
4. Bring to boil (just for a minute or so). Keep stirring!!
5. if you want, you can add a tablespoon of (white) sugar while it's still hot, for extra strength.
6. To adhere wheatpaste, apply it to both sides of the paper with a roller or sponge.





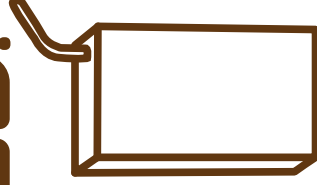
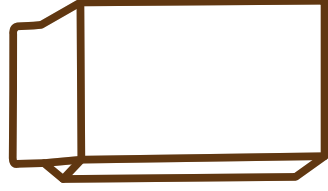
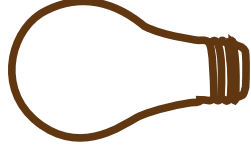
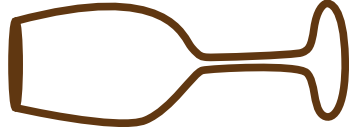
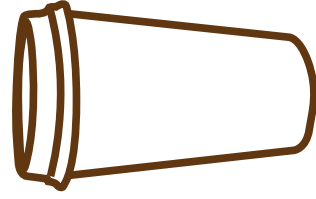

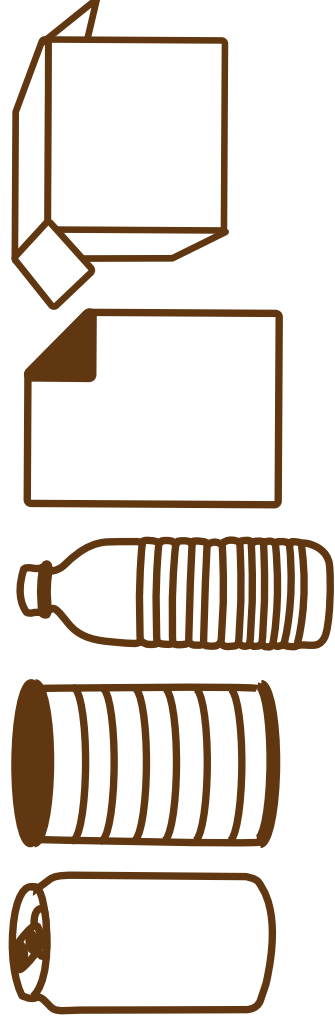
DISTANCE materials will travel to be recycled



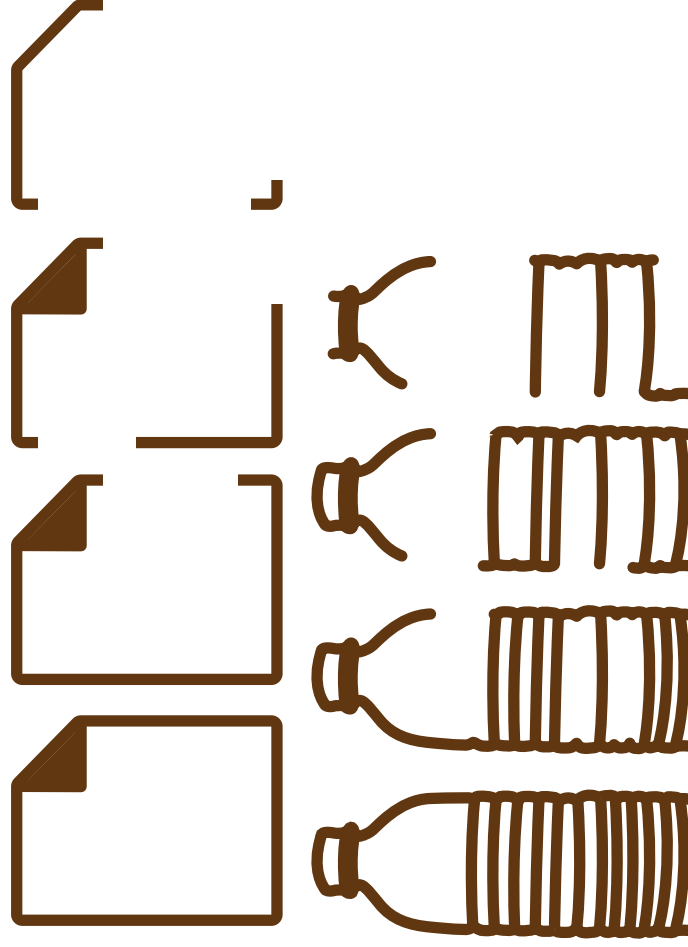
Some of this trash is
